

# Yukon Divisional Race Calendar Guiding Principles

Last update: September 2025

#### 1. What is new in season 2025/26

- In addition to the date for the Yukon Championship, we clarified that CCY will also set the date for Arctic Winter Games (AWG) trials.
- Beyond that, there is nothing else new this season. Last year's race calendar guidelines worked guite well.

## 2. What guides the Yukon Divisional Race Calendar?

- CCY will be working with affiliate clubs to optimize opportunities for all Yukon skiers and for all affiliates hosting the events.
- Affiliate clubs are responsible for selecting the date of their club races. CCY will select the race date for the Yukon Championship and Arctic Winter Games trials.
- CCY will provide information about which tier 1 and 2 races **outside of Yuko**n will be attended by Yukon's high-performance/ squad athletes.
- Only races of affiliate club members will be published in the Yukon divisional race calendar.
- CCY has set **timelines** for publishing the divisional race calendar (for details see below):

September: 1st publicationOctober: 2nd publication

- Ongoing: further affiliate club race dates are added as they become available throughout the season.
- This document will be updated prior to each race season.
- **Divisional race goals roadmap:** As CCY will establish roadmap goals for Yukon divisional races, those goals will further guide the race calendar.

#### Yukon Divisional Race Calendar: Process & Timeline

#### Prior to September/ 1st publication

- Tier 1 & 2 races outside Yukon: The Yukon divisional race calendar will be developed after the FIS calendar for international races and Nordiq Canada's calendar for national races has been published.
- **Tier 1 & 2 race selection:** The head coach of CCY's high-performance ski program selects the races to be attended by Yukon's high-performance athletes. This information is provided through the race calendar.

#### 1st publication: September

- When: CCY will publish the divisional race calendar in September, with the following information:
- What:
  - Yukon Championship race date
  - Information about races with potential participation of Yukon high-performance/ squad athletes.
- Where: The race calendar will be published on the CCY website.

#### 2nd publication and ongoing updates: October & ongoing

 What: Affiliate clubs will select race dates for their club races, in consultation with CCY. Through the race calendar, affiliate clubs will have information about potential conflicts for selected race dates.



- CCY will also consult with Biathlon Yukon in an effort to minimize race conflicts between the two sports.
- When: CCY will publish race dates for club races in October. Further updates will be made throughout the year, as more race dates become available.
- Where: The race calendar will be published on the CCY website.
