

Cross Country Yukon

Constitution Purposes

Established May 31, 2022

The purposes of Cross Country Yukon are to:

- a) Function and represent within the bylaws of Nordiq Canada and to act as the sport governing body of cross country skiing within the Yukon Territory so far as its authority extends.
- b) Promote competitive and recreational cross country skiing through the development of support structures for all cross country ski programs throughout the Yukon Territory.
- c) Govern the organization and conduct of cross country ski competitions within the territory, including Yukon Cross Country Ski Championships.
- d) Promote excellence in cross country skiing through the selection of high performance athletes to the Yukon Cross Country Ski Team and to support that team with coaching assistance, and travel assistance to high performance national and international competitions.
- e) Establish and maintain, through programs and activities, a system that supports the delivery of high performance athletes to the Yukon Cross Country Ski Team.
- f) Encourage and assist in the formation of cross country ski clubs within the territory.
- g) Encourage self-development, leadership and sportsmanship in cross country skiing.
- h) Accept donations, gifts, legacies and bequests.
